

Maple Manor Modified Rules & Regulations for the 2021 Season

**Last update: April 20, 2021*

Thank you for being with us for the 2021 summer. As directed by local health authorities, Maple Manor Swim Club has developed a list of guidelines to maintain a safe environment for all members. **Since staff will be monitoring pool usage and safety, we ask members to monitor their own families in upholding these rules.** Please keep in mind we reserve the right to remove your privileges if rules can not be followed.

1. Out of respect for other members and staff, members should follow all guidance and requirements set by the [CDC](#), [local government](#), and health experts during the course of their visit. Most importantly, members may not utilize the Club when they, or any member in their family, are sick, experiencing any of the symptoms associated with COVID-19 or recently exposed to COVID-19.
2. Masks: CDC guidelines state that swim clubs should encourage the use of cloth face coverings as feasible. Face coverings are most essential in times when physical distancing is difficult. A face covering will be **required** for members aged 3 and over as they enter and exit Maple Manor, when using the restrooms, and when ordering from the snack bar. In addition we ask that you wear a face covering any time you are unable to consistently maintain a distance of six feet from individuals who are not members of your household, such as walking through crowded areas of the club. Face coverings should not be worn in the pool at any time. Our staff will be wearing face coverings when they are not on the lifeguard stand. This is subject to change as we get further guidance.
3. The Club will allow the use of Maple Manor chairs this summer in a modified fashion. Both lounge and regular chairs will be available this year, although fewer than in priority seasons. Cleaning supplies will be provided and we ask that you wipe down your own chairs when you are done for the day. In addition, we will allow members to bring their own chairs as well. While some Maple Manor chairs may be placed on the pool deck, no personal chairs are allowed on the pool deck at any time. If you would like to leave your chair at the club, please mark it clearly with your name and find a place along the fence to keep it until you return. Your chair should be placed right up against the fence so it is not an obstruction. We encourage you to take your chairs home each Wednesday so that they do not interfere with lawn services. Your chairs should not be put with another family's chairs. The Club, staff and managers are not liable for chairs left at the club.
4. Take advantage of our large grounds and spread out to ensure social distancing. **Please respect the wishes and comfort levels of others.**
5. Guests are permitted this year at the Club. A reminder that our rules and regulations state that each family membership is allotted **8** guests per calendar month with no carryover from month to month. Also, no guest is allowed more than **5** total visits per season. Each guest will need to fill out a [form](#) at the front desk (also available on the website) and be accompanied by a bond member. Please greet your guest at the front desk. Managers will monitor compliance with the guest policy. Guest passes must be purchased in advance through the [MM Management System](#) (When selecting your family's membership type, there is an "Additional Options" section where you can purchase guest passes. Note, you can purchase a maximum of 20 guest passes at a time, and these passes will never expire.) No cash will be accepted at the front desk.

6. As always, we ask that each member (whether adult or child) individually log in with his or her Club-issued identification and admission tag at the Front Desk **every time** he or she enters the Club. Replacement tags are available for \$1 each, if needed. Please email secretary@maplemanorswimclub.org.
7. A reminder that expectorating or blowing of the nose and spitting into the pools or around the pool areas is prohibited.
8. Please remember, masks are required by patrons 3 years of age and older while in the restroom area. Showers remain closed at this time.
9. We will have staff cleaning high touch surfaces. Members should wash hands often with soap and water or with hand sanitizer.
10. We will be open during our regular hours, but this could vary if conditions change.
11. Members should adhere to social distancing guidelines while **in and out** of the water and make every effort to observe 6-foot distancing between individuals not in your household. Please avoid congregating in large groups. Bond holders are responsible for the conduct of all persons admitted to the club under his or her bond. A reminder that it is your responsibility to ensure your children adhere to the rules and guidelines while at the Club.

Thank you for helping us support our staff while implementing these guidelines. The Board of Directors created these guidelines to provide for a successful and safe summer. We look forward to seeing you at the pool!
